This letter is written pursuant to 930 CMR 5.08(2)(d)(2). I have accepted an invitation from the Jewish Community Relations Council of Boston (located at 126 High St., Boston, MA 02110; phone: 617-437-8600; email: info@jcrcboston.org) to attend an educational seminar in Israel from December 3, 2013 until December 13, 2013.

The goal of the seminar is to provide useful information, contact, and context to community leaders in Massachusetts to:

- Create or further opportunities for shared economic development in areas including health care, life sciences, bio-tech, and human and social services;
- Gain information that will help participants better respond to questions;
- Enhance the Boston-Haifa partnership; and
- Explore common challenges to work towards shared solutions.

To that end, participants will have the opportunity to hear from religious and business leaders, academics, media and government officials. We will also meet with Jews, Muslims and Christians, Israelis and Palestinians; people representing the widest spectrum of political and social thought. The group will travel the length and breadth of the country, exploring sites of historical and religious significance, including Boston's partner city, Haifa.

I feel that my proposed travel will serve a legitimate public purpose because it will promote the interests of the Commonwealth and enable me to be a more effective and knowledgeable legislator. The benefit to the House of Representatives and my constituents outweighs any non-work related benefit to me.

The total cost of the seminar is \$5,500 and I will receive a \$3,250 subsidy.
