#### Dear Jamey:

As part of its organizational process, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission is about to consider adoption of a variety of personnel policies, including policies that deal with vacations, sick leave, insurance, benefits and other common ingredients of a comprehensive personnel policy. In addition, pursuant to G.L. c. 23K, § 3(m), the Commission will soon begin work on a code of ethics that is more restrictive than the code contained in G.L. c. 268A and 268B. The more restrictive code may, among other things, impose restrictions on the financial affairs of Commissioners and Commission staff more stringent that those contained in existing law.

The activities just described trigger the reporting and determination requirements contained in G.L. c. 268A, § 6. Accordingly, I am enclosing a letter to Treasurer Grossman containing the required disclosure and requesting that he make the appropriate determination. I am also enclosing a similar letter from Commissioners Cameron and Stebbins.

As part of its organizational process, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission is about to consider adoption of a variety of personnel policies, including policies that deal with vacations, sick leave, insurance, benefits and other common ingredients of a comprehensive personnel policy. In addition, pursuant to G.L. c. 23K, § 3(m), the Commission will soon begin work on a code of ethics that is more restrictive than the code contained in G.L. c. 268A and 268B. The more restrictive code may, among other things, impose restrictions on the financial affairs of Commissioners and Commission staff more stringent that those contained in existing law.

Although my duties as a Commissioner require me to participate in creation and promulgation of the personnel policies and ethics code just described, those policies and that code may affect my personal financial interests. If so, participation in the creation and promulgation process would amount to participation in a "particular matter" in which I have a financial interest. Therefore, pursuant to G.L. c. 268A, § 6, I am notifying you, as my appointing authority, of the issue and requesting that you make the determination § 6 requires. For that purpose, I am enclosing the form the State Ethics Commission has created for reporting like matters.
