I am writing to you to disclose that I own a construction business and am an employer and that I also employ a full time domestic worker who serves as a nanny.

The House is considering House, No. 3983—An Act relative to workforce reform. Among the issues covered by the proposed general legislation are the minimum wage, unemployment insurance and other employment provisions. If adopted, legislation relative to these topics would arguably have an effect on my financial interests which is different from the effect on the general public.

I make this disclosure pursuant to G.L. c. 268A, s. 6A and consider it public in nature.
