
Dear Commissioners:

I am writing to you to disclose that I am a part-owner of a law firm and my family employs a domestic worker.

The House is considering House, No. 3983—An Act relative to workforce reform. Among the issues covered by the proposed general legislation are the minimum wage, unemployment insurance and other employment provisions. If adopted, legislation relative to these topics would arguably have an effect on my financial interests which is different from the effect on the general public.
