Participants will have the opportunity to learn counter-terrorism strategies and tactics, with special emphasis on suicide bombing and securing transportation infrastructure. The knowledge gained in these activities and presentations will aid in creating a more secure Commonwealth, and will allow the participants to have a greater understanding on security and terrorism issues.
