Service Contract Between Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and Holyoke Public School District

This Agreement is made this <u>21 s T</u>day of July 2015 between the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (the "Department") and the Holyoke Public School District ("HPS").

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.L. c. 69, § 1K, the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (the "Board") voted on April 28, 2015 to declare HPS to be a chronically underperforming district and directed the Commissioner of Elementary and Secondary Education (the "Commissioner") to take action consistent with law as needed for the benefit of Holyoke students, including appointment of a Receiver for the district; and

WHEREAS, the Receiver will exercise the powers of the superintendent and school committee for the benefit of the district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.L. c. 69, § 1K and 604 CMR 2.06(3), the Commissioner appointed Stephen Zrike as Receiver, effective July 6, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained in this Agreement and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. HPS agrees to compensate the Department for the following costs associated with the employment of the Receiver:
 - Salary, including payment for accrued leave, holidays, and FMLA or any other state or federally mandated or provided leave;
 - Actual employer share of medical, dental, and vision insurance;
 - 11.99% of direct salary costs for retirement, terminal leave, unemployment insurance, and universal health insurance assessments;
 - Actual costs associated with workers compensation insurance claims; and
 - Travel expenses incurred by the Receiver in the conduct of his duties, in accordance with the Commonwealth's travel expense reimbursement policies.

2. HPS will:

- Directly fund or reimburse the Receiver for conference fees and registrations, professional development, and professional fees or dues associated with the Receiver's performance of the duties of the superintendent and school committee; and
- Provide telephones, computers, and like equipment as needed by the Receiver for the performance of the duties of the superintendent and school committee.

3. Term of Agreement

• This agreement will cover the term of the Receiver's employment.

4. Payment Terms

- The Department will provide HPS with an estimate of anticipated costs for the receiver on a fiscal year basis to assist with HPS's budgetary planning purposes.
- The Department will bill HPS on a quarterly basis for costs associated with the employment of the Receiver.
- HPS will reimburse the Department within 45 days of receipt of invoice from the Department.
- Payments will be made via electronic funds transfer (EFT).
