Dear Chancellor Reyes,

I am writing to request your approval in compliance with the Conflict of Interest Law on Spousal Hire, so that the university can complete the process of hiring my spouse Scott Davidson as the Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs with a concurrent appointment as Professor with tenure in the Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures (LLC) in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts (HFA) for which I serve as Dean.

In his role as Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs, Professor Scott Davidson will be supervised by John Wells, Senior Vice Provost for Lifelong Learning, and Farshid Hajir, Senior Vice Provost & Dean of Undergraduate Education. The position of Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs is a full-time position in the Provost's office. As such, Professor Davidson will have no specifically required assigned research, service, or teaching duties in HFA while he is serving as Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs. However, since Professor Davidson will also have a concurrent appointment in LLC which is housed in HFA, he will be a faculty member in HFA, with all the rights and privileges that come with that appointment. Therefore, in order to comply with university policies and state ethics laws, I have sought and obtained the support of my supervisor, Provost Fouad Abd-El-Khalick, to recuse myself from all supervisory duties related to the performance of Scott Davidson as a faculty member in LLC or in any other capacity. As such, I will not participate in any personnel actions related to Professor Davidson, such as tenure, promotion, annual faculty report, requests for leave, evaluation for awards/honors, etc. and I request that Provost Abd-El-Khalick assign any and all such tasks to an appropriate person other than myself as he sees fit. I am concurrently filing a disclosure from with the State Ethics Commission to the same purpose. I therefore respectfully request your determination regarding this disclosure for the next 12-month period. I intend to file such a disclosure on an annual basis.

Dear Dean Davidson:

I acknowledge receipt of your Disclosure of Financial Interest and Memorandum, both dated February 28, 2025. You request permission to allow the Provost's Office to complete the process of hiring your spouse, Scott Davidson, as the Associate Provost for Interdisciplinary Programs with a concurrent appointment as Professor with tenure in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts, Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures, for a three-year appointment, beginning March 3, 2025. The salary for the first 12-month period (March 3, 2025 – March 2, 2026) will be \$193,333.00, at 100% FTE.

As further detailed in your Disclosure and Memorandum, although Professor Davidson will not have any specific duties as a faculty member in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts, Department of Languages, Literatures and Cultures, there are occasions where you ordinarily would be called upon to oversee Professor Davidson's faculty activities, but you have asked your supervisor, Provost Fouad Abd-El-Khalick, to assign all such tasks to another. According to Senior Vice Provost for Lifelong Learning John Wells' and Senior Vice Provost and Dean of Undergraduate Education Farshid, Hajir's memorandum, dated February 28, 2025, Scott Davidson's performance will be directly supervised by John Wells with a secondary indirect reporting line to Farshid Hajir. Both Wells and Hajir will jointly assign duties which include leading, managing, and facilitating collaboration and strategic planning to align programs with the University's strategic vision for lifelong learning.

Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 268A, Section 6, in part, prohibits a state employee from employing immediate family members and from compensating them for services rendered except when I "assign the particular matter to another employee […], in which case it shall not be a violation for [. . . you] to participate in the particular matter."

My determination, which allows the Provost's Office utilization of your spouse's services for one (1) year (March 3, 2025 – March 2, 2026), must be reviewed and re-evaluated prior to any further appointment. Please submit your request to the Chancellor of the Amherst campus to make such a review and re-evaluation by January 2, 2026, if you wish the Provost's Office to continue to employ your husband, Scott Davidson, as an Associate Provost of Interdisciplinary Programs with a concurrent appointment as

Professor with tenure in the College of Humanities and Fine Arts, Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures, beyond March 2, 2026.

The statute requires you to advise the Ethics Commission of the nature and circumstances of the particular matter and make full disclosure of that financial interest. As directed by statute, I am sending a copy of this written determination letter along with your memorandum and disclosure form to the State Ethics Commission for filing.

Dean Lupe Davidson will be excluded from Prof. Scott Davidson's tenure review or any other personnel actions such as Annual Faculty Reports, grant proposals, evaluation for internal or external awards and honors, etc. All such matters relating to Professor Scott Davidson which are internal to the college of Humanities and Fine Arts (HFA) and would be ordinarily be handled by the Dean of HFA would be assigned to an appropriate Associate Dean in HFA or another person as determined by Dean Davidson's supervisor, Provost Abd-El-Khalick.
